Former member of the Board of the Mont Pelerin Society, member of the Academic Advisory Council of the Institute of Economic Affairs (London), Adjunct Scholar of Cato Institute (Washington DC), Associate Scholar of the Ludwig von Mises Institute (Auburn), has received honorary degrees from Argentina's and foreign Universities and is member of the Institute for the Methodology of Social Sciences at the National Academy of Moral and Political Sciences, in Buenos Aires. Former Full Professor of Economics at the University of Buenos Aires, author of twenty four books and coauthored six more, current President of the Academic Council of Argentina's Freedom and Progress Foundation and President of the Editorial Board of Argentina's Branch of Unión Editorial (Madrid).
